
X. COMMUNITY RESOURCES

1. Service Categories (Table X-1)

Community resources in this section refer to the Valley's network of agency and program resources responding to family, social, physical, and life cycle needs. Their work is helping to fill many gaps for services, and making the Valley a more responsive and caring place to live.

Table X-1 provides a list of representative agencies and programs compiled in 2002, with 11 service (or need) categories, and 72 agencies across the Valley responding to them. Service categories and examples are as follows:

- Social services --- Colorado Rural Legal Services. Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish Church.
- Family support --- Alcoholics Anonymous. Hospice del Valle.
- Housing services --- La Puente Homeless Shelter. Tu Casa.
- Health/nutrition --- Colorado Baby Care/Kids Care Program. Women, Infant, and Children's Nutrition Program.
- Emergency assistance --- American Red Cross. SLV Search and Rescue.
- Disabilities --- Blue Peaks Developmental Services. Health Care Program for Children with Special Needs.
- Child daycare and preschool services --- Noah's Ark Child Care. TSJC's Preschool & Child Care program.
- Parenting programs --- Head Start Programs. Home Intervention Program.
- Youth activities --- 4-H Youth Program. Boys and Girls Club.
- Youth outreach services --- Adams State College Talent Search. Migrant Education Program.
- Programs for seniors --- Casa de Oro Adult Day Care. Senior Meals on Wheels.
